

Dear Member:

I have enclosed the Asbestos Workers Local 14 Scholarship Fund application form for your use please read the eligibility and application requirements below.

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

To qualify for a scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Be a member of Local 14.
- 2. Be a full-time continuous employee of any employer that has a labor contract with Local 14.
- 3. Alternatively, be a dependent child (26 years of age or younger) or spouse of an active, retired, disabled, or deceased member who is or was a full-time continuous employee.

For the purposes of this scholarship, a "child of a member" includes any dependent natural, adopted, or stepchild of the member.

To be qualified applicant, the applicant must: 1) have graduated from an accredited high school, equivalency program, or trade school with a "C" average or better, 2) have completed any entrance examination required by the institution of continuing education which the candidate has selected, and 3) have applied to and been accepted by an accredited institution of continuing education, including a trade school, college, or university.

**High School Graduate - Applying for the first time: **

Please provide a copy of your high school diploma and transcript, or a copy of your GED certificate along with your scores. Additionally, include a copy of the scores for any required admission tests.

**High School Senior: **

Your application must include a copy of your most recent grades. You will need to provide your diploma and final grades if you are awarded a scholarship. Additionally, include a copy of the scores for any required admissions test.

**College-Enrolled Applicants: **

Your application must include a copy of your most recent grades or transcript. If you are applying for the Asbestos Workers Local 14 Scholarship for the first time, please provide a copy of the scores for any required admission tests, as well as a copy of your diploma and your final grades if a scholarship is awarded. Additionally, you must attach a copy of scores for any required admission tests.

The enclosed scholarship application must be returned to the Union Office no later than <u>April 30, 2025</u>, if it is to be considered for this year's awards.
