Asbestos Workers Local 14 Scholarship

I have enclosed a scholarship application for your use. Please read the eligibility and application requirements noted below.

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible for a scholarship, an applicant must be a member of Local 14 who is a full-time continuous employee of any Employer having a labor contract with Local 14 or the dependent child (26 years of age or under) or spouse of an active, retired, disabled, or deceased member who is or was a full-time continuous employee. A child of a member shall include any dependent natural, adopted, or stepchild of the member.

To be a qualified applicant, the applicant must: 1) have graduated from an accredited high school, equivalency program, or trade school with a “C” average or better, 2) have completed any entrance examination required by the institution of continuing education which the candidate has selected, and 3) have applied to and been accepted by an accredited institution of continuing education, including a trade school, college, or university.

Your application must include the following:

High School Graduate – Applying for the first time: Your application must include a copy of a High School diploma and transcript or a copy of a GED certificate and scores. Also, attach a copy of the scores for any required admissions test.

High School Senior: Your application must include a copy of your most recent grades. You will need to supply your diploma and final grades if a scholarship is awarded. Also, attach a copy of the scores for any required admissions test.

College-Enrolled Applicants: Your application must include a copy of your latest grades and or transcript. **Please note** that if applying for the Asbestos Workers Local 14 Scholarship for the first time, a copy of scores for any required admissions test is required.

The enclosed scholarship application must be returned to the Union Office no later than April 30, 2026, if it is to be considered for this year’s awards.
